

Coronavirus Covid-19 Precautions**CAA Exam Candidate Information and Declaration.**

CAA, are currently taking a few simple precautions to protect you, CAA colleagues and exam venue staff from possible infection from the current Coronavirus Covid -19 outbreak. As a result, we need you to read the information below and complete this declaration.

This advice applies to all CAA exam candidates and follows Public Health England guidance.

You will be unable to enter our exam room if you:

1. show any signs of the coronavirus such as cough, a high temperature or shortness of breath. You should self isolate and follow the PHE *COVID-19: stay at home guidance*.
2. have been in contact with someone with confirmed coronavirus in the last 14 days.
3. live in or have travelled from a location that is currently subject to additional country wide coronavirus restrictions.
4. have recently travelled to the UK and you have not complied with the UK Government Quarantine / Self Isolation requirements for any persons entering the UK.

During your visit you are reminded to keep following good hygiene practices.

Do

- wash your hands with soap and water often – do this for at least 20 seconds
- use hand alcohol sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available
- cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze
- put used tissues in the bin straight away and wash your hands afterwards
- wear face covering to reduce potential droplet spread

Don't

- do not touch your eyes, nose, mouth or face covering if your hands are not clean
